THE BOYS IN THE BOAT (PG) 135 Mins *Sports, Drama*

Based on the non-fiction novel about the 1936 University of Washington rowing team that competed for gold at the 1936 Berlin Olympic games, this true story follows a group of underdogs at the height of the Great Depression as they're thrust into the spotlight and take on elite international rivals.

THE COLOUR PURPLE (M) 150 Mins *Drama, Musical*

Torn apart from her sister and her children, Celie faces many hardships in life, including an abusive husband. ONE LIFE (PG) 115 Mins *Biography*

The inspiring true story of Sir Nicholas 'Nicky' Winton, whose unsung endeavours on the eve of World War II saved more than 600 children from their doom at the hands of the Nazis. Nicky considered himself a banker, not a humanitarian. Yet when he visited a recently annexed Prague in 1938 and saw the state of the fleeing Jewish refugees, he did what he believed was the right thing to do – the thing that anyone would do – and dedicated himself to the cause.

THE JUNGLE BUNCH WORLD TOUR (PG) 95 Mins *Animation, Adventure*
