THE IRON CLAW (MA15+) 140 Mins *Biography*

The true story of the inseparable Von Erich brothers, who made history in the intensely competitive world of professional wrestling in the early 1980s. Through tragedy and triumph, under the shadow of their domineering father and coach, the brothers seek larger-than-life immortality on the biggest stage in sports.

MADAME WEB (CTC) 120 Mins *Action*

In a switch from the typical genre, Madame Web tells the standalone origin story of one of Marvel publishing's most enigmatic heroines. The suspense-driven thriller stars Dakota Johnson as Cassandra Webb, a paramedic in Manhattan who may have clairvoyant abilities. Forced to confront revelations about her past, she forges a relationship with three young women destined for powerful futures...if they can all survive a deadly present.

ARGYLLE (M) 145 Mins *Action*

A razor-witted, reality-bending, globe-encircling spy thriller. Elly Conway is a reclusive author of a series of best-selling espionage novels, whose idea of bliss is a night at home with her computer and her cat, Alfie. But when the plots of Elly's fictional books—which centre on secret agent Argyll and his mission to unravel a global spy syndicate—begin to mirror the covert actions of a real-life spy organization, quiet evenings at home become a thing of the past as the line between Elly's fictional world and her real one begins to blur.

THE HOLDOVERS (M) 140 Mins *Comedy*

Nobody likes teacher Paul - not his students, not his fellow faculty, not the headmaster, who all find his pomposity and rigidity exasperating. With no family and nowhere to go over Christmas holiday in 1970, Paul remains at school to supervise students unable to journey home. With a trouble-making 15-year-old named Angus and head cook Mary, whose own son was recently lost in Vietnam, these three very different shipwrecked people form an unlikely Christmas family sharing comic misadventures during two very snowy weeks in New England. ONE LIFE (PG) 115 Mins *Biography*

The inspiring true story of Sir Nicholas 'Nicky' Winton, whose unsung endeavours on the eve of World War II saved more than 600 children from their doom at the hands of the Nazis. Nicky considered himself a banker, not a humanitarian. Yet when he visited a recently annexed Prague in 1938 and saw the state of the fleeing Jewish refugees, he did what he believed was the right thing to do – the thing that anyone would do – and dedicated himself to the cause.

MEAN GIRLS (PG) 120 Mins *Musical, Comedy*

New student Cady Heron is welcomed into the top of the social food chain by the elite group of popular girls called "The Plastics," ruled by the conniving queen bee Regina George and her minions Gretchen and Karen. However, when Cady makes the major misstep of falling for Regina's ex-boyfriend Aaron Samuels, she finds herself prey in Regina's crosshairs.

FORCE OF NATURE: THE DRY 2 (M) 125 Mins *Mystery, Drama, Thriller*


In Force of Nature: The Dry 2, when five women take part in a corporate hiking retreat and only four come out on the other side, Federal Agents Aaron Falk and Carmen Cooper head deep into the Victorian mountain ranges to investigate in the hopes of finding their whistle-blowing informant, Alice Russell, alive.

ANYONE BUT YOU (MA15+) 110 Mins *Comedy*

Bea and Ben look like the perfect couple, but after an amazing first date something happens that turns their fiery hot attraction ice cold — until they find themselves unexpectedly thrust together at a wedding in Australia. So they do what any two mature adults would do - pretend to be a couple.

THE COLOUR PURPLE (M) 150 Mins *Drama, Musical*

Torn apart from her sister and her children, Celie faces many hardships in life, including an abusive husband. With support from a sultry singer named Shug Avery, as well as her stand-her-ground stepdaughter, Celie ultimately finds extraordinary strength in the unbreakable bonds of a new kind of sisterhood.
