KINGDOM OF THE PLANET OF THE APES (M) 150 Mins Action

Set several generations in the future following Caesar's reign, in which apes are the dominant species living harmoniously and humans have been reduced to living in the shadows. As a new tyrannical ape leader builds his empire, one young ape undertakes a harrowing journey that will cause him to question all that he has known about the past and to make choices that will define a future for apes and humans alike.

IF (PG) 125 Mins Comedy

IF is about a girl who discovers that she can see everyone's imaginary friends — and what she does with that superpower — as she embarks on a magical adventure to reconnect forgotten IFs with their kids.

GOLDA (PG) 105 Mins Biography

Set during the tense 19 days of the Yom Kippur War in 1973. Helen Mirren stars as Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meir, who is faced with the potential of Israel's complete destruction, must navigate overwhelming odds, a skeptical cabinet and a complex relationship with US Secretary of State Henry Kissinger, with millions of lives in the balance. Her tough leadership and compassion would ultimately decide the fate of her nation and leave her with a controversial legacy around the world.
