ZOOTOPIA 2 (PG) 115 Mins Adventure/Animation

Detectives Judy Hopps (voiced by Ginnifer Goodwin) and Nick Wilde (voiced by Jason Bateman) find themselves on the twisting trail of a mysterious reptile who arrives in Zootopia and turns the animal metropolis upside down. To crack the case, Judy and Nick must go undercover to unexpected new parts of town, where their growing partnership is tested like never before.

WAKE UP DEAD MAN: A KNIVES OUT MYSTERY (M) 150 Mins Comedy/Crime

WICKED FOR GOOD (PG) 145 Mins Musical/Fantasy/Family
